 Breakfast Club began in July 2020 with six concerned conservatives meeting around a table in a side room at Sandy's Pancake House in Lightfoot, Virginia. They knew action was needed but didn't know where to start.

As attendance grew, they began each meeting by having "first-timers" introduce themselves, give a brief background, and indicate what was their main political interest/passion.

HUMBLE BEGINNINGS



Soon attendance outgrew the ability of the restaurant's wait staff to deliver timely meals.

- The group took over the main restaurant area in Sandy's and shifted to a buffet-style breakfast, although menu orders are still accommodated.
- Soon even the main room was filled each Tuesday. Some were driving 45 minutes or more to attend. New clubs were needed!
